

Leadership and the Leap of Perception

For years, in the worlds of physics, business, spirituality, and even politics, we've heard about the *paradigm shift*, *quantum leap*, *new world order*, *tipping point*, *new age*, and *holographic reality*. Thomas Kuhn popularized the concept of "paradigm shift" in 1962, defining evolution as a "series of peaceful interludes punctuated by intellectually violent revolutions," within which "one conceptual world view is replaced by another." So a paradigm shift implies a huge change in the way we experience life, one that results in a behavior and identity change.



What might transform our sense of self and world? How about: the acceleration of matter resulting in a much higher-frequency energy and consciousness? How about: the integration of the nonphysical or spiritual dimension with the physical world?

As you and the world vibrate at a higher frequency, your perception naturally expands; your worldview shifts as your vibration shifts. At a higher frequency, you become conscious of the nonphysical world; you perceive yourself and everything as made of energy rather than as solid bodies or objects separated by empty space. In effect, you can "see through" or "feel into" the solidity of matter to experience the energy patterns inside.

Cause-and-effect ceases to be the primary rule for materializing results; miraculous, mysterious, immediate results occur with no logical explanation. What you want to create happens effortlessly, in a twinkling. Much more is contained in the present moment than ever before; the "now" mushrooms to include increasing amounts of the past and future. With everything in the moment with you, you don't have to wait for answers, assistance, or results. You just ask and receive. Compassion becomes the real power behind evolution.

Leadership transforms, too. No longer is it a matter of a hierarchical, linear power structure with a big boss at the top. Now leadership is an experience of shared, co-creative responsibility, which feels like play. The key question is: Who leads? Truthfully, everyone does. The "flow" leads, because the "flow" is the movement of the collective consciousness of all beings, and it is always appropriate, always in the moment.

New leadership focuses on ways to read and facilitate the group mind, on ways to release each person's destiny, soul motivation, and evolving excellence. It no longer tolerates ego, power mongering, secrecy, or hoarding of resources. The idea of success is also redefined. Setting and attaining goals is a new proposition, too, as everything now exists in the present moment and evolves constantly. We cannot use willpower, cannot "project" outcomes as we used to do. The whole notion of re-viewing things we have known in the old reality to understand how they will function in the new Intuition Age reality is totally fascinating to me.
